

## Construction Futures Centre - Covid-19 Visitor Information

The health and safety of our visitors is our top priority at CTF and the Construction Futures Centre (CFC).

To meet the WA Government requirements and medical health advice, CTF have a Covid - 19 Safety plan in place and have implemented the following measures to provide and maintain a safe environment for our visitors.

- Increased frequency of cleaning to all touchable surfaces in the Construction Futures Centre by CTF staff including any handheld devices, railings, headphones, flooring, exhibits and their surrounds, etc.
- Provided touchless hand sanitiser stations and sanitising wipes that have been placed around the CFC for employees and visitors to use during their time at the venue.
- Seating has been arranged in the lecture theatre by CFC staff to ensure the 2 square metre rule is being adhered to for each group.
- Enlisted a specialist cleaner to clean, disinfect and sanitise the venue each day after visitor use including all touchable surfaces.
- Ensuring CFC facilitators have completed the COVIDsafe Training.
- Assist health authorities with contact tracing if required and/or requested.
- Ensuring visitors are aware of best hygiene practices whilst at the Construction Futures Centre including displaying signage around the facility on hand washing, physical distancing and good hygiene practices.

### What we need you to do:

- If you or someone in your group feel unwell, stay home and visit us when you/they are better.
- Use the hand sanitiser provided upon entry to the CFC. If any visitors are allergic to hand sanitiser, we ask that they supply their own or they will have the opportunity to wash their hands with soap and water in the Centre toilets.
- Wipe down any shared equipment such as headphones, keyboards, Virtual Reality headset, etc before and after use.
- Maintain the 1.5 metre physical distancing rule around others if you are not part of the same group of visitors.
- Supervisors and students over the age of 16 will be required to check in using the SafeWA app on their mobiles or complete a secure paper based contact register upon arrival. We will require their name, phone number, date and arrival time. This a mandatory requirement of the WA Government and Department of Health to assist with contact tracing if required.

We will continue to follow advice provided from the Western Australian Government and Department of Health and make changes as needed to continue providing our visitors with a safe environment.
